Technology for Both Options:

- Student iPads K-12
 - Portable Wifi Hotspots for staff and students as needed
 - Synchronous Classroom Camera Device for DB Blended Digital Learning
 - iPad for students in the Blazer Virtual Academy partnership with Edgenuity
 - DB Help Desk support for students and teachers
 - K-12 Technology Coach
 - Each building has a virtual learning facilitator
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In class technology:

- Our digital classrooms will be powered by Logitech Meetup cameras.
- The device is mounted on a cart which contains a Mac Mini to facilitate sharing content from iPads or any desktop application to the stream. Includes a TV mounted on a cart so the teacher can visually see the remote students, rather than their presence being audio only to help facilitate a more personal connection and increase engagement.
