Dear Daniel Boone School District Families,

Earlier this week, U.S. Secretary of Agriculture announced that they were extending a program which allows Free Breakfast and Lunches to be provided to school students through December 31, 2020. The Pennsylvania Department of Education sent guidance Wednesday Afternoon September 2nd on how to apply and implement this program.

Beginning on Tuesday September 8th Daniel Boone Area School District will begin offering a FREE breakfast and Free lunch to each student for every school day. This also includes the meals handed out for those students learning virtually.

We will follow the same protocol for placing orders for Virtual Learners with a cutoff date of every Friday orders placed by 12 noon. And a pick-up date of every Tuesday between 8:30-9:30am at the selected pick up location. Please refer to the Virtual Learners Meal Order Form on the Daniel Boone Food Services Home Page for information.

At this time the free meals for all students will only run until December 31, 2020 at which time statuses will return to Paid, Free and Reduced rates based on qualifications and applications so please return free and reduced meal applications as soon as possible to avoid any gap in benefits.

We remain committed to providing students access to healthy, nutritious and wholesome meals while assuring the utmost food safety without compromising quality. Please feel free to contact me if there are any questions.
